Mini Golf Classic Team Tournament Program Overview

The Team Craft Miniature Golf Tournament

In this fun competition, teams design a miniature golf course and then challenge each other to a tournament.

Teams with from 5 to 9 participants design, construct, and establish par for one hole of a miniature golf course.

The assignment is for each team to develop one challenging fairway and putting green using materials provided, and then to play all the holes constructed by the teams involved to determine a winning team.

Each team follows a set of construction guidelines that ensures a variety of challenging but doable holes. Tournament play employs a handicap process to ensure a fair team challenge. The program can be conducted either indoors or outside.

The team with the lowest cumulative stroke score wins. Prizes can also be awarded for most creative and challenging designs.

A debrief discussion at the end of the activity, led by the facilitators, links winning team strategies and behaviors to effective team practices in the workplace.

Typical Schedule for the program:

Example Time Schedule: approximately 3.5 to 4 hours

15 minutes - program introduction

15 minutes - Warm-up/Ice Breaker activities – teams formed

45 to 60 minutes - construction time – test/practice time

15 to 20 minutes – Par and handicap setting

20 to 30 minutes—Tournament play

15 minutes—Awards

20 minutes Debrief time – key learning and applications to work

Awards: for the winning team – and other possible categories . . .

Teamwork medals awarded to first place team

Additional awards can be presented in categories such as . . .

Team Spirit award – Most Challenging Design award
